### US Fencing Election Timeline

April 1, 2008 - Signatures on all petitions are validated and results are sent to the Election Committee.

May 1, 2008 - Ballots are mailed out to all USFA voting members (members who are at least 18 years of age on Feb 1, 2008).

June 15, 2008 - Approximate date for all ballots to be received by the USFA for counting (official date is 14 days before the annual meeting which will be held during the first week of the summer nationals in July)
